## **Eligibility for SFMNP Food Benefits:**

- Age Must be 60 years of age or older on the day of application, AND
- **Income** Applicants' gross household income must not exceed these limits:

\$2,096 monthly for a household of 1
\$2,823 monthly for a household of 2
\$3,552 monthly for a household of 3
\$4,279 monthly for a household of 4
\$5,006 monthly for a household of 5
\$4,835 monthly for a household of 6

(Household: a group of related or non-related individuals living together as one economic unit. These amounts are at 185% of 2022-2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines.)
